



## **ALCA MEMBERSHIP TYPES**

- Professional Membership is open to all active American Counseling Association members and to all persons professionally engaged in guidance, counseling, or personnel activities in educational, vocational, religious, rehabilitation, employment agencies, or other such similar agencies. (Minimally holds Counseling Degree).
- Regular Membership shall include persons whose interests and activities are consistent with those of the Association, but who are not
  qualified for Professional Membership.
- Student Membership is open to any graduate or undergraduate student who is not employed full-time in a counseling-related position and who is actively engaged in a program of study in counseling, guidance, or personnel. (Certification by advisor is required).
- · Retired Membership is open to persons who were members of ALCA at the time of their retirement.
- Past Presidents are persons who have served as ALCA Presidents: Dues are complimentary.
